

## Several accidents reported on rainy Thursday

LAKE COUNTY &ndash; Vehicle accidents were reported around Lake County on Thursday as wet rainy conditions prevailed throughout the day.

On Thursday morning, traffic issues started with the report of traffic signal problems at Highway 29 and Soda Bay Road. Caltrans was called to fix the problem.

A vehicle versus pedestrian crash was reported in front of the Nice Market at 2:40 p.m., with a male subject injured. No further information was available Thursday.

Other collisions reported Thursday:

4:37 p.m. &ndash; Two-vehicle collision resulting in major injuries on Highway 20 in front of Sentry Market.

5:48 p.m. &ndash; A solo vehicle spin out on Highway 20 just east of Red Hill Lane. No injuries.

6:14 p.m. &ndash; A collision with one victim trapped and expected to be transported to the hospital. The crash occurred on Highway 29 at mile marker 15.

6:27 p.m. &ndash; A crash with no injuries on Highway 20 in front of the Lake Marina Motel. The vehicle reportedly went between 40 and 50 feet off the roadway.

7:33 p.m. &ndash; Traffic collision with no injuries on Tenaya at Soda Bay Road.

No further information on the crashes was available Thursday evening.
